- The **PrintingOnline and delivery** service costs **59€ + 21% VAT = 71.39€**
- Collect it on-site at the Registration Desk.


What is the production quality of the poster produced?

- The poster is available with 4 colour printing on 200g/m² photographic paper.
- Poster size **90 x 120 cm portrait (vertical)**.

When is the deadline?


- The deadline for submitting a poster is **29th October 2018 at 23:59 (GMT+1)**.

Correct dimensions



A common mistake in posters we receive is incorrect dimensions. This can cause distortion to the final format for printing.

These are the correct poster dimensions:



Please set up your poster correctly in PowerPoint:
